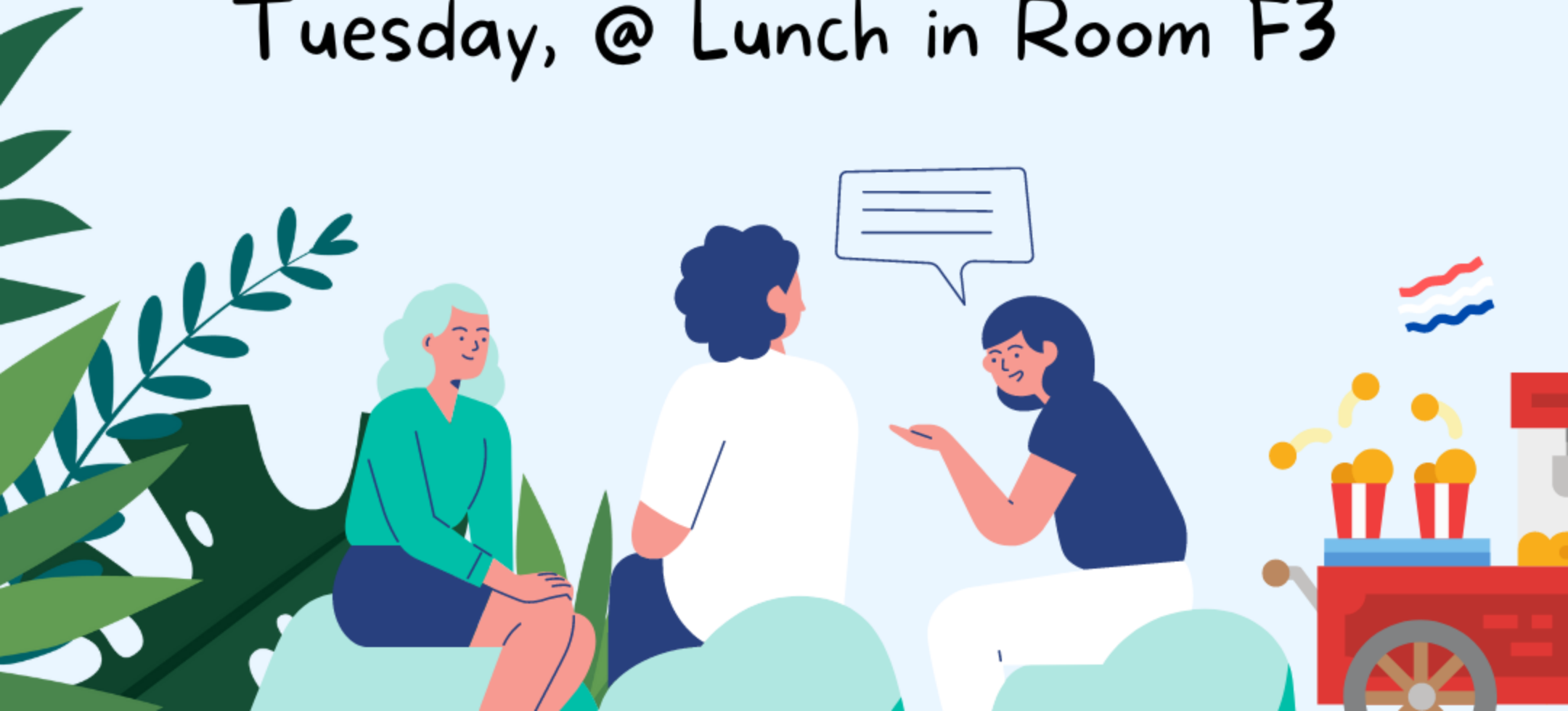

## The role of a Student Board Member:

“To solicit the views of fellow constituents and represent that on the board. Represent the high school and the surrounding community.”

“Often the board doesn’t have the direct relations to students so student members can relay relevant context.”

### Three Essential Roles in School Districts

1. Strategic, visionary role  
Big picture leadership  
Governance team

2. Tactical role  
Planning, logistics, articulation  
Administration

3. Operational Role  
Day-to-day implementation  
Teachers and other staff



## Tips for incoming student board members:

- Look at your board's bylaws and BB9000 to see exactly what the role is of your school board.
- A governance calendar helps to keep track of responsibilities of a governance team and its deadlines.
- A governance handbook establishes a unity of purpose, the norms of roles and responsibilities, and specific protocols.
- It is best to address issues as they occur, not wait
- Students should practice active listening while maintaining respect towards other members and being kind.



# The Brown Act

- Applies to all public entities, but schools in particular
- People have the right to access information concerning the conduct of the people's business.
- The board holds the obligation to provide advanced notice of a scheduled board meeting and create the means accessible for attendance.
  - 72 hr notice for regular meeting
  - 24 hr notice for special meeting
  - 1 hr notice for emergency meeting (in dire circumstances)
- Closed session (generally involving union negotiations, student punishments, and human resources) are closed to both student board members and the general public.
- Public comment may include anything, on or off the agenda, that is within the jurisdiction of the board. The public can also formally request to add items to the meeting agenda prior to its occurrence.

## Pertaining to the role of a student board member:

- Preferential vote (vote does not formally count)
  - However, a student board member holds the right to express a formal opinion that must be noted in the minutes of the meeting.
- Boards can pass a resolution allowing student members to make a motion.  
EDC § 35120
- Students are not liable for decisions of the board.
- A student board member can be appointed to a board committee
- A student board member must not have weight in discussions of closed session or human resources.
- A student must not be an intermediary for communication between board members (called a serial meeting)
